Send an email to computerwaitinglist@digital-inclusion.lu:

- 1) Device type: **laptop, desktop, or extra family desktop** (the waiting time for a desktop is much shorter)
- 2) Name
- 3) First name
- 4) Current address
- 5) Telephone number
- 6) Social security number (blue card)
- 7) **Attach proof of eligibility:**
 - a. For DPIS: copy of ONA file (pink paper)
 - b. For other residents:
 - copy of card for social grocery stores; OR copy of recent REVIS; OR referral from social assistant.
 - If you apply for a laptop, copy of a recent "*Certificat de residence élargi*".

If you sent a **COMPLETE** application, you will receive a confirmation email.

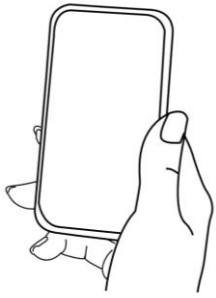

Why should I get a computer?



I don't need a computer, I can use my smartphone to write emails and look up information.

But a computer can help you to do so much more!



As our society becomes more and more digitalised, you may find a smartphone can't do all the things you need. A computer can help you reach the next level, whether you are a student, looking for a job, or hoping to start your own business.

How can a computer help me?

- ✓ **Write like a pro:** write and send longer emails, write official letters, attach documents.
- ✓ **Upgrade your homework:** complete homework online, create presentations for class, access online learning platforms.
- ✓ **Find a job:** write a CV, search and apply for jobs online, use common tools like Word and Excel with confidence, follow free online courses to learn new skills.
- ✓ **Be your own boss:** Create a website, advertise your services, learn to keep accounts, sell your products online, create invoices, register your business.
- ✓ **Administrative tasks:** Apply for official paperwork, register to vote, find information on your legal rights, learn whether you can get support from the government or other organisations.
